CALENDAR CHANGES

Round 4 was washed out on both the original date and on the rain date, so at this stage we are going to hold it over and see if we can fit it in later in the season. We will let everyone know if and when this may be.

We have been able to take advantage of a last minute cancellation at the showground and have decided to move Round 5 from the 22nd July to the 29th July out of respect to our members who race at both our club and at NSWSKC.

New Compulsory Airbox Update

Due to ongoing design issues and a lack of testing on speedway with the new compulsory airbox, CCSKC and NSWSKC delegates were able to petition the AKA and get the implementation date pushed back until 1st January 2008. The airbox applies to all classes except KT Modified and Formula 100/Sportsman classes.

Don't forget that you will no longer be sent a new Karting Manual with your new licence from the AKA. They are available from our Race Office now, with or without a licence renewal. Please remember that every licence holder is required to have a current Karting Manual. Please ensure that you get yours before the State Titles.

These stickers will be supplied by the AKA and you will be required to display a minimum of 1 on the Nassau Panel of all karts at all AKA events. There is no indication of any cost to karters at this stage. They will be compulsory by the 1st January 2008.

NSW Speedway Kart State Titles 2007

We are proud to be hosting the NSW Speedway Kart State Titles again this year on 15th - 16th September. Going by previous years, it's going to be a truly awesome event with well in excess of 100 karters taking part.

Organisation is already under way and further information will be released shortly.

Camping will again be permitted at the Showground on both Friday and Saturday nights with power and full amenities available onsite.

We will also be hosting a family dinner again on the Saturday night which is shaping up to be bigger than anything we have done before, so don't miss out as bookings are essential for catering. There will be plenty of games, prizes and entertainment to make it a fun and memorable event. Details will be available at a later date.

King of the Dirt Wrap Up

With some fantastic racing under lights, Alan Hann of Coastal Skips, our major sponsor, was extremely pleased with the popular Saturday day/night format, and has indicated his intention to sponsor the event again next year.

With over 90 karts entered, and our pit area bulging at the seams, all the drivers were also anticipating a great race meeting. There was to be plenty of racing with 4 heats and a final for all the classes, with the 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the final, taking home the trophies.

The practice sessions and first 2 heats were marred by plenty of people fouling plugs, especially when the sun had gone down and the cool night air arrived, but as the night went on, the drivers and crews adapted their setups successfully.

The track was wet initially, and with a light grade and pack down after the Heat 1 rounds, it stayed fairly smooth and consistent all night, with little extra water required. The main racing line slickened up over the night, but 2 lane racing was still possible in many of the classes.

In the Midgets, Daniel Cassidy is the newly crowned King, after winning 2 heats, and coming a close 2nd and 3rd in the others. Joel Middlemass and Daniel Sayre were hot on his heels, but couldn't catch him in the Final.

In one of our largest Rookie fields for a while, Sean Richards took the crown, from Matthew Pescod and Reagan Angel. With these top 3 drivers, on roughly equal points after the heats, it was going to be anybodies race.

With 14 Juniors entered, it was going to be a tough night to shine, but local Nathan Bailey did just that, claiming the crown, even after a DNF in one of the heats. Bradley Griffin and Michael Jordan were never far behind taking the minor placings. An up and coming driver - Joel Bond, placed 5th and has been a great improver since joining the Junior ranks this year. It was also great to see James Kovacic come and have some fun on the dirt.

There were also 14 entries in the hotly contested Clubman Light class. Matthew Goff managed to avoid any racing incidents and ended up the King, after taking 3 2nd places in the heats. Matt Dalton overcome 2 DNF's in the heats to take second, and Natalie Genner ended up taking 3rd, also only one of a few drivers to complete every race. Heat 4 in this class, only had 4 drivers finish after 2 racing incidents in turn 1 that saw almost the whole field crash out.

With a full field of Clubman Heavies, Wayne Baines is the newly crowned King, with Graham Keats a hard charging 2nd. Tim Baker, whom we haven't seen for a while, came in 3rd, even after 2 DNF's in the heats. With numbers down in this class recently, it was great to see new blood with 5 new P-platers.

The Over 40s class was a hard slog, with any driver capable of winning with luck on their side. Mick Martin, Greg Smidt, Dave Taylor and Stuart Bond each took a heat win. But the eventual King became Craig Ford, with some consistent driving and starting from Pos 2 in the Final. Stuart Bond ended up 2nd and Dave Taylor took out 3rd after starting from Pos 4.

The KT Modified/Open class was split into Light and Heavy for this event and boy was the racing competitive. In the Lights, the return of David Hopping saw him take the honours, with 3 race wins on the night. 2nd was Graham Keats, and 3rd Matthew Troy.

In the KT Heavy class, Craig Banks slogged it out with Graham Keats all night, with Craig taking the win, and Graham running 2nd. Shane Orre grabbed a respectable 3rd with some consistent driving all night.

The Formula 100/Sportsman class returned at this meeting to assault the Gosford track, and Jonathan Bright took the honours with a runaway win in the feature. Graham Keats was 2nd (again) after starting on pole and Gavin Wesble ran 3rd. The other heat winner was Donald Stevens in Heat 2.

Special mention must go to Graham Keats for racing in 4 different classes. He certainly must be keen and very fit. Even after hitting the wall in one heat, and visiting the ambulance, he was unlucky not to snare a win, and instead took home 4 x 2nd place trophies.

2007 Race Day Roster

All club members are required to participate in the season roster as allocated. Not all members will be allocated roster dates in each season as there are many more members than dates and duties available, therefore you may only be allocated dates every second year where possible.

- o Parents will carry out the duty for all Midget, Rookie and Junior competitors. The competitor will still be allowed to compete for points on that day.
- o You may elect to have another person do your duty for you, but they must be over 16 years of age and preferably have some knowledge of racing.
- o You may swap dates with other members on the roster, however you have to arrange this yourself and notify the Club Secretary one (1) week prior to the race meeting it affects.
OUR CLUB SECRETARY WILL NOT ARRANGE ANY CHANGES ON YOUR BEHALF.
- o **FAILURE TO CARRY OUT YOUR ALLOCATED DUTY DATE WILL RESULT IN YOUR NOT BEING PERMITTED TO COMPETE AT ANY OF OUR RACE MEETINGS UNTIL YOU HAVE COMPLETED YOUR ROSTER DAY.**
- o Roster duties may be - Flags, Grid Marshall, Gate Marshall, Weigh Marshall. The list of duties may vary from time to time.

Please report to the Race Office by 8.00am on the morning you are rostered on and jobs will be distributed then. If you have a preferred job you can ring the secretary on 4385 6433 or email secretary@ccskc.com.au prior to race day and reserve that job.

Written description and instructions are available from the Race Office for each position if needed, plus the Clerk of Course will ensure that you are familiar with the requirements for each job at the Officials Briefing prior to the commencement of racing. During the meeting if you have any doubts or questions you may contact either the Clerk of Course, Chief Steward or Race Office via your radio for assistance.

Health and Safety Obligations

No doubt you are all aware of the increase in official inspections of motor racing facilities (including the pit/paddock area's) by state and local authorities, aimed at reducing the risk of accident and injury to participants, volunteers and members of the public. It is the responsibility of the competitor / team / association: ***“so far as it is practicable, to provide a working environment that is safe and without risks to health”.***

Under State Health & Safety Regulations, temporary garage facilities at a race meeting are regarded as a temporary workplace, which means they must comply with regulations.

Whilst Regulations vary slightly between States, the aim is similar – **SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT.**

The essential points to comply with are:-

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

ELECTRICAL POWER LEADS MUST NOT BE RUN ALONG THE GROUND.

- If you are taking power from a distribution point (genset/power point) to your truck/trailer/tent/shelter, you must suspend the cable above the ground,
 - at a minimum height of 2 meters in a pedestrian area,
 - **OR** high enough to clear the largest vehicle accessing the area.

EXTENSION LEADS & POWER TOOLS

- Power leads, power boards and power tools should be tested, inspected and tagged every 12 months.
- Gensets should be fitted with an earth lead and stake.

FIRE SAFETY

AT LEAST ONE, OPERABLE, 1KG POWDER (FUEL TYPE) FIRE EXTINGUISHER PER COMPETING KART IS TO BE EASILY ACCESSIBLE AND VISIBLE AT THE REAR OF YOUR AREA. (SUPPLIED BY AND RESPONSIBILITY OF KARTER).

- During re-fuelling an extinguisher is to be placed within arms length of the kart, so it can be reached quickly in the event of a fuel fire and or spillage.
- Do not store fuel in the tent/shelter area; keep it in the trailer/truck until needed.
- Fuel is to be stored in approved containers only with the appropriate labelling (Australian Standards Approved).

WORK SAFELY

- Avoid placing any objects in a position that could create a tripping accident.
- Be aware of ventilation when refuelling karts or using cleaning fluids.
- When warming kart engines (in the designated areas) wear ear protection.
- Wear eye protection when using striking tools or grinding.

ACCIDENTS

- Any injury received in the work place (pit/paddock area) must be reported to officials of the meeting.
- The reporting of accidents will provide information to help prevent future similar accidents.

Club Rules

- No one is allowed on the Greyhound track. Parents please assist by keeping the children off at all times.
- Please use the bins provided for ALL of your rubbish.
- No smoking or naked flames in the Pits or Grid.
- No open shoes or bare feet in the pits, grid area or infield.
- Race suits MUST be in good condition with working zippers.
- Ankle boots must be worn when racing.
- Parents of our younger members please make sure that our Midgets & Rookies can identify and know the meaning of all the Flags.
- Abuse or swearing at Officials or fellow competitors WILL NOT be tolerated & suspension will apply.
- Don't forget our Wet Weather hotline 0412 976 922. Race meetings will be called either on or off at 6am on race morning.
- Quads only to be used to push start Karts on the track. They are not to be ridden around the pit area or used to tow karts. These rules will be enforced by the Clerk of Course.
- Quad drivers to be over the age of 16.
- One (1) person to be on any Quad AT ALL TIMES.
- Helmets & Safety Vest to be worn AT ALL TIMES.
- All restricted classes may use any AKA approved dry/slick and or wet tyre from any previous AKA Manual at CCSKC tracks. Tyres may be hand grooved.
 - No 6-inch diameter tyres or Burris tyres allowed in restricted classes.
